Conduct Policy:

It is the policy of St. John Youth Baseball and Babe Ruth to promote the development of strong character, positive attitude, a sense of responsibility, and good citizenship in its youngsters. It is the purpose of St. John Youth Baseball and Babe Ruth to achieve this through fair play, good sportsmanship and congenial fellowship, with adult leaders providing the example while attempting to limit injury. It is strictly against the policy of St. John Youth Baseball and Babe Ruth for any person, either as a participant or spectator, to engage in arguments, to use abusive language, harass Umpires, Managers, Coaches, Players, Board Members, or other spectators, or to exhibit any behavior not in concert with the general intentions of this policy statement.

Sportsmanship Policy:

Members of one team shall not ride, heckle, poke fun of at or in any other manner do anything that in the opinion of the Umpire or Board Members distracts the opposing team. The penalty for violation of this rule shall be removal of the guilty players and/or Manager and/or Coach from the game and from the dugout.

- I hereby pledge to provide support, care, and encouragement for the children on my Team and all other children participating in league activities by following this Code of Conduct.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, Coaches and Officials at every game, practice, or other league events.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of the children ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my children play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will remember that the game is for youth – not adults.

League Commitment:

I agree to support and participate in all St. John Youth Baseball and Babe Ruth functions that include but are not limited to, Field Maintenance (prior to and during the season), Facility Upkeep, Opening Day Events, Fundraising, Player and Coaches Clinics, Skills Day, Regular and Post Season Tournaments and any other situations where my assistance will be of benefit to all players in the league. I will make an attempt to stay informed about the league and attend the monthly General Board Meetings. I understand this is an ALL VOLUNTEER effort and there is a lot of work required by all the people involved in St. John Youth Baseball and Babe Ruth beyond just my child or my team. I agree to this commitment and will dedicate my time to that cause to rest of my abilities. If at any time I cannot fulfill my obligations, I will seek the assistance of my commissioner in the league or I will offer my help to anyone who needs it. I have read and will abide by all the conditions set forth in the St. John Youth Baseball and Babe Ruth Conduct and Sportsmanship policy.

I understand that if I violate these policies, I could be subject to removal from the fields by St. John Youth Baseball and Babe Ruth Officials, and/or Umpires. I am also subject to a review by the Disciplinary Review Board.
